Gould Health Systems is seeking feedback from testing partners (pharmacies and software vendors) to assist with our preparation to implement NCPDP D.Ø by the January 1, 2Ø12 deadline. Below is a summary of information regarding our upcoming pilot testing in preparation for NCPDP D.Ø implementation.

1. We will not require certification.

3. We expect to have our payer sheets available in late August 2Ø11.
4. Test Plan/Test Cases for all plans will be available beginning in September 2Ø11.
5. You will be testing with your current NPI, which should be on file with GHS.
6. We will provide a test BIN to use for testing each applicable plan.
7. We encourage you to test for each plan applicable to your business.
8. We will be providing you with test cases, test patient data as well as distinct test scenarios for pilot testing.

10. We will be sending out future notices regarding NCPDP D.0 implementation via fax blast as well as posting to the above website. Once you are registered to participate in pilot testing, you will be contacted directly from our implementation team.
